QUESTION

YOU = 7 OF CUPS

The Seven of Cups shows that you are, indeed, confronted by options. You will need to work out what's most important to you, not only in the present, but the future. Do not be tempted by opportunities that offer short-term pleasure,

but long-term pain (especially one night stands or quick flings). Think about what your long term-goals are and commit to a realistic outcome.
